Any sex knowledge without a wise understanding of God's moral laws, can be extremely dangerous. So Should we consider boycotting these particular chemists as a parental protest?

RELIGIOUS INSTRUCTION

The Dept. of Education is forming a committee to sit at the end of this Month to review the whole question of R.I. in schools and to advise whether Clause 20 of the Education Act needs to be amended. Recommendations have been invited from the University staff and students. Should not this rather be a matter for parents to consider, since it affects us and our children? R.I. in schools maintains the Christian character of our schools, under our Christian Australian Constitution, bearing in mind that 90% of our population is Christian in outlook. If you want R.I. retained, please let us know, and write also to Education Dept. Copies of Mr. Fletcher's Memorandum to University Staff can be had on application.

CIFTS TO SCHOOL LIBRARIES

It is our intention to make available to selected schools decent and uplifting literature in an attempt to counteract the permicious and even subversive books which have found their way into school libraries. ### Editorial

OUR CHANGING TIMES

Almost 3,000 years ago Isaiah recorded a message from God, predicting the upsurge of atheism and the outmoding of Christian conventions, resulting in a revolt by women and teemagers against God's decree of submission to husbands and fathers and to law and authority. We can see in society's present revolutionary stew, a fulfilment of this prophecy - the old paths have indeed been destroyed right here in our generation, by Women's Liberation and student unrest - JUST AS GOD SAID!

Over the centuries the breath of God has blown upon the sea of humanity, pervading and influencing it for good, so that our Christian conventions became rooted in the lives and hearts of individuals, enriching the whole of human society in the process.

But the wheel has almost turned the full circle, and we are in the winter of our existence. Atheistic opinion has caused modern man to take off the worn-out clothing of the past and to become a nudist colony, with no covering for his shame.

Society has been cooking this up for a long time - engaging in a deliberate mixing of the necessary ingredients to ensure results. And - to our shame - many adults are actually encouraging this current revolt against time-honoured conventions, against God and His laws, against the Bible and all it stands for.

Think of the distorted ideas we give the young on how to be adult. What about the permicious literature in High School libraries - termed "adult reading" for "mature" students, and the obscene "R" films shown to 18 year olds - and labelled "adult viewing". Aren't we telling our youth that adulthood no longer implies maturity and self-restraint, but rather it is to be equated with freedom to rebel and to sin, as though God did not exist to judge our actions? Where are the standards, and the absolutes? - the perfections to aim for? - that all contributed towards making growing up so easy for us? Why were they discarded?

All the present-day evils can be traced to the outmoding of just ONE essential convention - the worship of God Almighty. As long as there was loyalty to God, there was no teenage problem, no drugs, but there was faithfulness and integrity in Marriage, with cordial bonds of love uniting families and there was a sense of duty and loyalty towards all in authority. These and other virtues, such as modesty, morality and chivalry, have been lost to us and to our children - sacrificed on the altars of atheism, and in the very act of discarding them, and the God who instituted and commended them, we have but fulfilled that prophecy which He Hinself made about our generation so long ago.
